



SNAPPER

Do you have psychosis or bipolar disorder?

Do you also have, or think you might have, untreated ADHD?

ADHD is a common mental disorder that involves problems with attention, overactivity and acting impulsively.

SNAPPER is a study looking at which of two types of medication works best at reducing the effects of ADHD in adults with psychosis or bipolar disorder.

People tend to associate ADHD with childhood but it often continues into adults. It is usually treated with medication.

You could help our research by taking part in the SNAPPER study

Why take part?

Doctors don't know yet which medications for ADHD work best in people who also have psychosis or bipolar disorder. We hope this study will help treatment of people with these conditions in the future.
